Summer Camps for 2007

All camps are taught by teachers holding a North Carolina teaching certificate.

Camp counselors will also have a background in education (teacher, teacher's assistant or student pursuing a degree in education).

Each camp will have a cap of twenty children, ensuring individual attention and top notch supervision.

Campology is a very student-centered, hands-on science program.

Nature

Campers will study plants and wildlife including frogs, butterflies, earthworms, birds, and bats. Scientific investigations are held in a classroom setting and in the outdoors and range from the dissection of an owl pellet to the collection of water from leaf transpiration. If your child likes to learn about the outdoors, this camp is for him or her.

Earth/Space Science

If your child has an interest in rocks and fossils or enjoys learning about space and planets, he or she will love this camp. Campers will be completing projects that teach them about the rock cycle, volcanoes and other landforms. In addition, they will learn about the solar system and even build and launch their own rocket.

Motion Technology

This camp is for children who like build things. They will learn about force, motion and other laws of physics while they construct miniature race cars and rockets. Campers will also perform activities that teach them about simple machines and their uses.

Crime Scene Investigation

Does your child like to solve mysteries? In this camp we will attempt to solve different crimes by analyzing handwriting and fingerprint samples, fibers from plants and animals, and other criminal evidence. Campers will learn the techniques of real crime scene investigators to solve a fictional crime.
